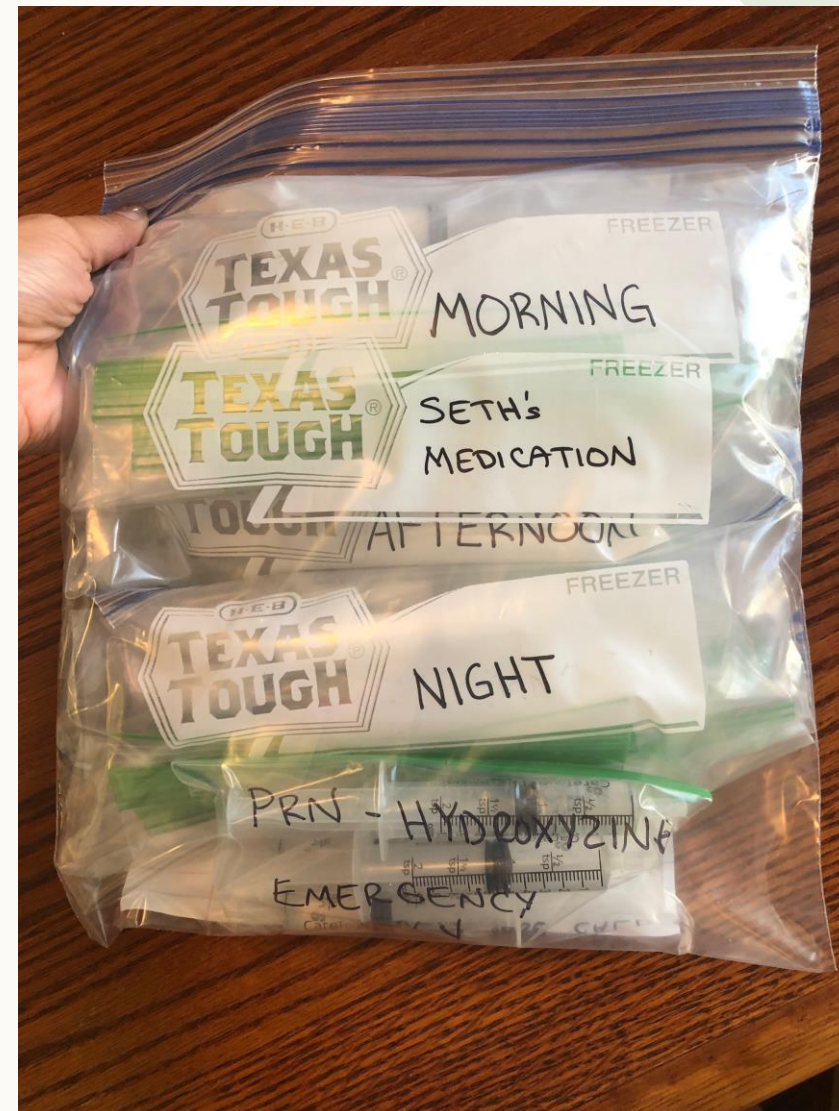

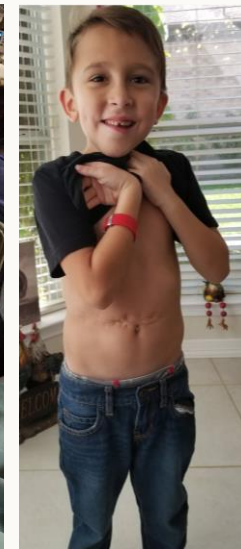

Prescription → Administration → Better Health



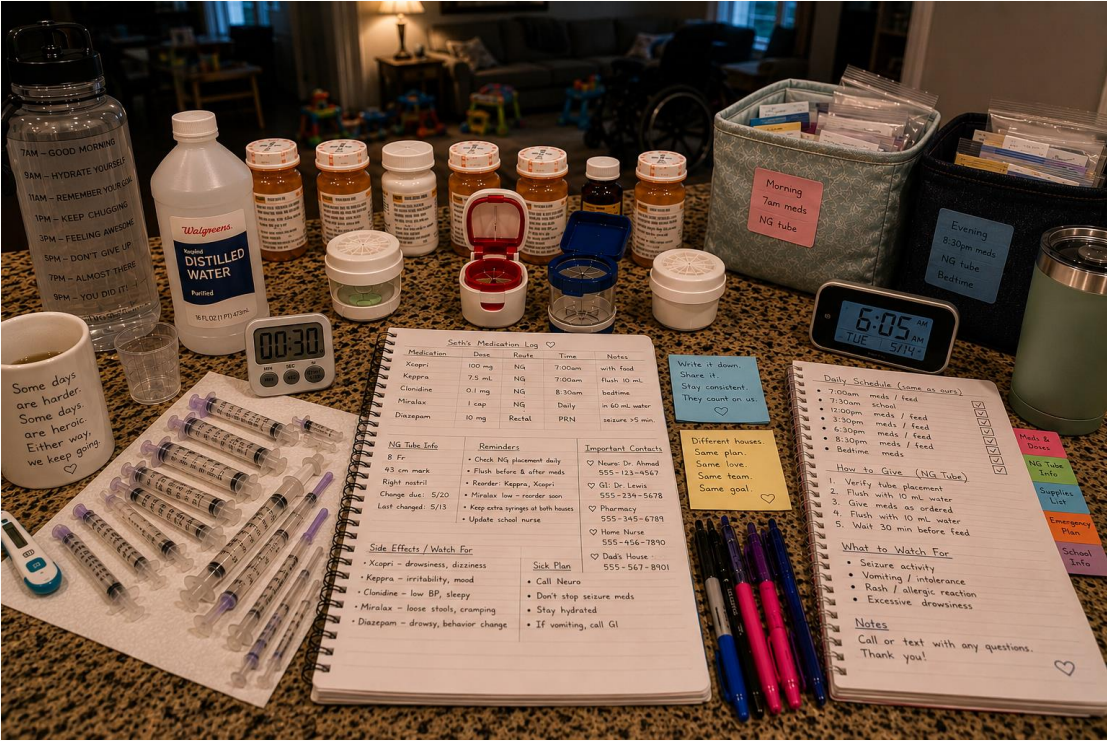
And yet...

Can it be measured accurately?

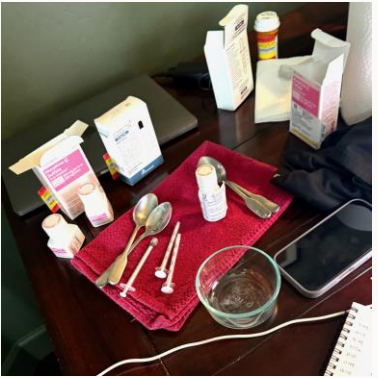
Can they tolerate it?

Can caregivers give it consistently?

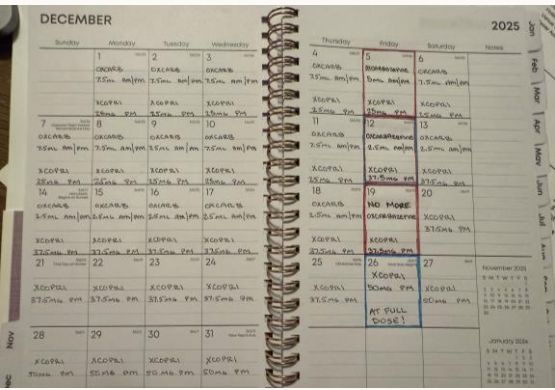
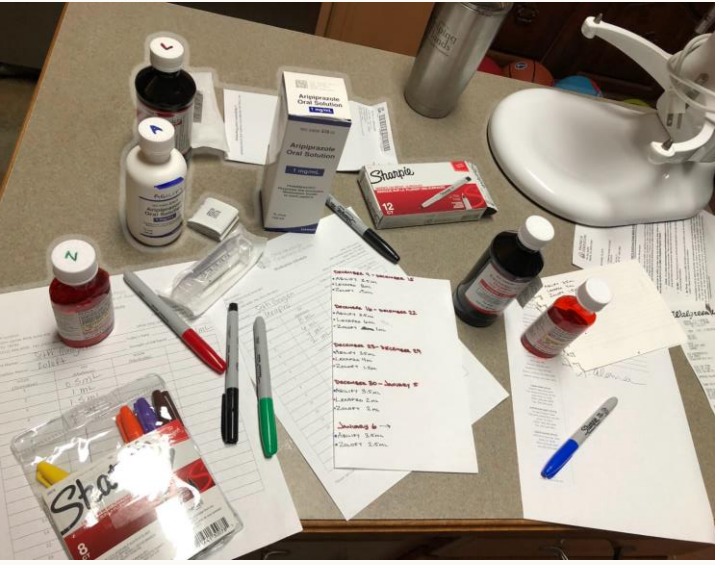


THE VIEW FROM

The Kitchen Counter.

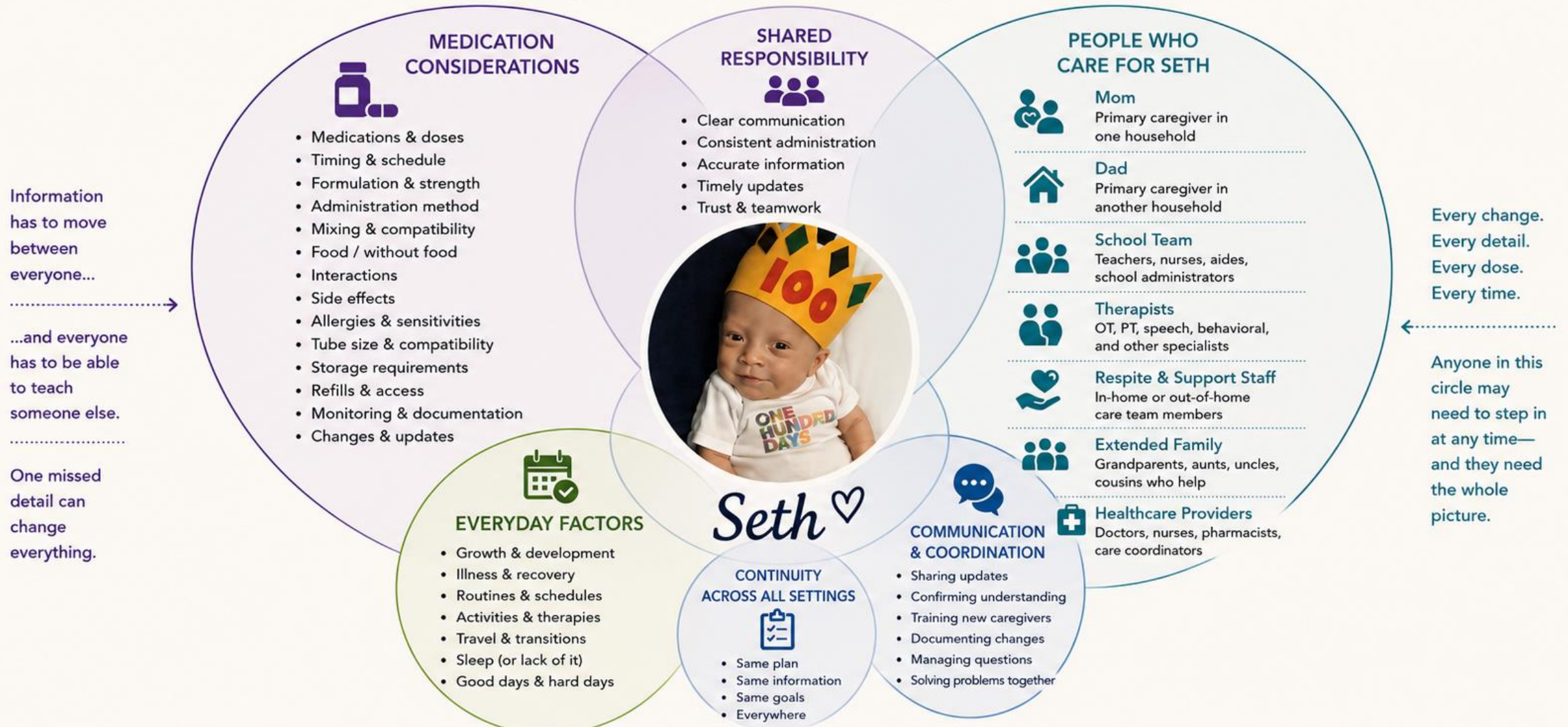
